### Call to Order

Sewer Utility Commission President Peter Hansen called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The following Sewer Utility Commission members were present: Peter Hansen, Sherry Gruhn, Terrence McMahon and Thomas Johnson. Lawrence Robers was absent. Also present were Sewer Utility Manager Gary Hanson, Engineer Mark Madsen and Clerk-Treasurer Michael McKinney.

## Amendment #1 of 2014 Sewer Utility Annual Budget

Hanson provided a summary of the proposed changes to the 2014 Sewer Utility Fund annual budget.

Motion (McMahon, Johnson) to approve the proposed amendments to the 2014 Sewer Utility Fund annual budget as submitted, MC.

### Reports

**Sewer Utility Manager's Report:** Hanson provided his report to the Sewer Utility Commission. He discussed the upcoming budget process, the phosphorus minimization report due to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources in February, and a change in the courier used by the Sewer Utility to transport sewer samples. He and the Commission

discussed an expansion of the area covered by the AECOM Sewer Utility feasibility study. The Commission opted to expand the boundaries of the study area south to include those properties along South Sylvania Avenue to the I-94/STH 11 interchange and chose to contract the western boundaries of the study area to exclude properties within the sewer service area that do not currently have access to sewer service. Hanson and the Commission also discussed the impacts of agriculture on phosphorus levels in surface water.

**Engineer's Report:** Madsen provided his report to the Sewer Utility Commission. He provided an update on the new sewer transmission pipe installed under I-94, noting that it was large enough to handle any discharge from the sewer treatment plant.

**Clerk's Report:** McKinney provided his report to the Sewer Utility Commission. He noted that sewer bills will be sent to customers at the end of September.

No comments, questions or suggestions were provided.
