Call to Order

Acting Water Utility District Commission President Sherry Gruhn called the meeting to order at 6:53 p.m.

Roll Call

Approval of Minutes

Motion (McMahon, DeBrabander) to approve the October 18, 2016 Water Utility District Commission meeting minutes as presented, Motion Carried (MC).

Approval of Water Utility District Financial Reports

Existing fire hydrant insurance coverage

McKinney noted that the utility's insurance provider currently insures the utility's fire hydrants at approximately \$9,660 per hydrant, adding that the cost to replace each hydrant is approximately \$8,000. He added that the premium savings that could be realized by reducing the value of the hydrants to match their replacement cost is approximately \$306. The Commission opted to make no changes to the hydrants' insured value.

Amendment #1 to the 2016 Water Utility Fund annual budget

McKinney noted that this amendment transfers funds to cover water plant repair expenses.
