The Village of Yorkville is requesting public input as we begin the process of creating an I-94 Corridor Master Plan and the Village's 2050 Comprehensive Plan. The two plans will be developed concurrently, yet incrementally and will be based on input gathered from the community.

I-94 Corridor Master Plan. Planning process to review current development pressures, to identify community supported options for future growth, and to create preferred land use scenarios with fiscal impacts. An implementation strategy will be identified for the chosen scenario.

2050 Comprehensive Plan. Planning process to develop a complete update to the Village's Comprehensive Plan with a focus on identifying goals and a community vision for the Village for the next 30 years, prioritized in an Implementation Plan.

The Village of Yorkville requests your participation by completing this survey to help inform this important community building effort. Each individual may take the survey once. We encourage each person in a household to complete the survey, adults and children.

The community survey is one of the first methods the Village will take to engage public participation in this process. Public information meetings will also occur and dates will be posted on the Village's website. The information gathered from the community during these public engagement efforts will build on itself ultimately leading to a community supported vision for Yorkville's future.
