# 1340 Grandview Parkway odor complaint

The Village Board discussed a complaint received by the Village regarding odors believed to have originated from the Daniels Sharpsmart facility located at 1340 Grandview Parkway. Kyle Little addressed the Village Board regarding this issue, stating that Daniels met the condition established in 2017 requiring the extension of their exhaust pipe by an additional 20 feet. He noted that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources does conduct routine inspections at this facility. The Village Board advised that any future odor-related incidents be reported to the Racine County Development Services Department and the Village. The Village Board opted to revisit this issue at their April 22 meeting.

Request submitted by Robert Vyvyan, Incorporated (with the Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners/Nielsen Madsen + Barber as applicant/agent) for shoreland contract approval for the property located at 17033 Washington Avenue (STH 20) (Parcel ID # 194-03-21-09-034-000) in the A-2 (General Farming and Residential II) Zoning District to permit bank and channel repair and cleaning within the shoreland jurisdiction of Tributary No. 3 of the West Branch of the Root River Canal

Motion (Nelson, Funk) to approve the proposal submitted by Westbrook Associated Engineers, Inc. for 2019 bridge inspection services as presented in the amount of \$1,525.00, MC.

## Bids for the 2019 67<sup>th</sup> Drive paving and drainage program project

Madsen stated that three combination base road repaving and alternate culvert replacement bids were received for this project, adding that the low combination bid for this work was submitted by Payne & Dolan in the amount of \$368,986.00, which is the bid that he recommended the Village Board accept.

Motion (Maurice, McMahon) to approve the base and alternate bids submitted by Payne & Dolan in the amount of \$368,986.00 for the 2019 67<sup>th</sup> Drive paving and drainage program project, MC.

### 16143 58<sup>th</sup> Road ditch/culvert repair request

Doug Nelson addressed the Village Board regarding this agenda item. He stated that the Village originally received an estimate from the Racine County Highway Department in 2017 for the replacement of his driveway culvert and for cleaning the ditch on both sides of the culvert to improve water flow. He added that he agreed to pay the cost of replacing the culvert if the Village would agree to pay the cost of cleaning out the ditch. McKinney noted that the estimate provided in 2017 for this project was \$3,190.00 for cleaning the ditch and \$1,110.00 for replacing the culvert. He added that he has requested but has yet to receive an updated estimate for this work from the Racine County Highway Department.

Motion (Maurice, Funk) to authorize that culvert replacement and ditch cleaning be done by the Racine County Highway Department on the property located at 16143 58<sup>th</sup> Road, with the property owner paying the cost of replacing the culvert and the Village paying the cost of cleaning out the ditch, MC.

**Code Enforcement Officer's Report:** O'Brien updated the Village Board on the status of the property located at 14017 Durand Avenue (STH 11). McKinney noted that eviction notices are being filed against the remaining occupants of the property.
