A RESOLUTION APPOINTING 2020-2021 ELECTION INSPECTORS

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE, RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes 7.30(4)(a) provides for the appointment of Election Inspectors by municipalities between December 1 and December 31 of each odd-numbered year for a two-year term, and

WHEREAS, current Election Inspector terms expire on December 31, 2019, and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes 7.30(4)(b) allows the two dominant parties to submit a list of names from which appointments shall be made, and

WHEREAS, the Republican Party has submitted a list of names for appointment as Election Inspectors, and

WHEREAS, the following individuals have expressed interest in serving as Election Inspectors for the upcoming appointment term, which begins on January 1, 2020, and ends on December 31, 2021:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that each of the above-listed individuals be named as Election Inspectors for the 2020-2021 term, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Jean Wilks and Judith Aimone be designated as Chief Election Inspectors, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to appoint additional Chief Election Inspectors as necessary, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, pursuant to Village of Yorkville Code of Ordinances 2-321(c), the minimum number of Election Inspectors required to work at each polling place during an election is three, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to schedule working hours for Election Inspectors and Chief Election Inspectors accordingly, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to post this resolution in three places within thirty days of its adoption, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution and the appointments contained herein take effect the day following the posting of this resolution.

This Resolution was adopted by the Yorkville Village Board on December 23, 2019.
