The WisDOT preferred improvement alternative is a resurfacing treatment with intersection improvements. Mainline pavement will receive a 2 1/2-inch mill and 4-inch Hot-Mix-Asphalt (HMA) overlay. Other work will include spot full-depth repairs, base patching, culvert repairs, intersection improvements at US 45 north (possible signal or roundabout), application of a High Friction Surface Treatment (HFST) on the horizontal curve at County D, signing, marking, and minor geometric improvements. Construction is anticipated to be in 2024.
