**PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY THE YORKVILLE SEWER AND WATER  
COMMISSION FOR YORKVILLE SEWER UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 REGARDING  
FACILITY PLANNING FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES**

A public hearing will be held during the meeting of the Yorkville Sewer and Water Commission on Tuesday, August 18, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., in the Village Board Room at the Union Grove Municipal Center, located at 925 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Union Grove, Wisconsin.

The purpose of the hearing is to discuss and review the Facilities Planning Document for the Yorkville Sewer Utility District No. 1's wastewater treatment facilities. Major equipment upgrades are scheduled to take place over the next few years for the purposes of achieving better ammonia, nitrogen, and phosphorus removal and to address short term growth within the utility district. These improvements include construction of a new raw wastewater lift station, relocation of the existing fine screen, construction of a new grit removal system, Sequencing Batch Reactor (SBR) system, interconnecting piping between the existing aeration basin and new system for sludge storage, and ancillary site improvements.

The public hearing will discuss:

- Population and Design Projections
- Current and Future Permit Requirements
- Alternatives Evaluated
- Review of Alternative Selected
- Implementation Schedule
- Environmental Effects
- Estimated User Charge Impacts

A copy of the Facilities Planning Document will be available for public inspection prior to the public hearing, beginning on Friday, July 31, 2020, and for at least two weeks during regular office hours at the Village Office at the Union Grove Municipal Center, located at 925 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Union Grove, Wisconsin.
