Sewer Utility District Manager's Report - Hanson reported to the Commission on the following:

- That the utility's annual chloride report has been sent to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, adding that chloride levels have dropped compared to last year
- That this year's commercial sewer manhole sampling program is almost complete
- That a sampling manhole installed on the property located at 14015 Grandview Parkway was damaged
- That a commercial utility customer made a request to discharge glycol into the utility system, adding that he denied this request
- That the final whole effluent toxicity test is being completed, adding that the utility passed its second test
- That he is cancelling this year's planned tour of the wastewater treatment facility due to the COVID-19 pandemic
- That the design of the upgrades to the wastewater treatment facility has begun
- The meeting held between utility and Racine County representatives regarding the proposed purchase of the parcel located immediately to the north of the existing wastewater treatment facility site

Water Utility District Manager's Report - Hanson reported to the Commission on the following:

- The meeting held between utility and Racine County representatives regarding the proposed purchase of a portion of the parcel located immediately to the northwest of the existing water tower site
- That hydrant flow tests will be completed in early August
- That he flushed hydrants
- That a hydrant in front of the property located at 14100 Grandview Parkway was damaged
- That water meters have been installed in both new buildings constructed at the south end of Grandview Business Park
- That there was a recent instance of water theft from the utility

Engineer's Report - Madsen updated the Commission on issues related to the Washington Avenue (STH 20) reconstruction project.

Administrator/Clerk's Report - McKinney stated that the sewer connection charge has been paid for the new development at the south end of Grandview Business Park.
