

Village Board & Planning Commission Joint Meeting Minutes

Union Grove Municipal Center 925 15th Avenue Monday, June 12, 2023

1. Village Board President, Douglas Nelson, called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

2. Roll Call

Motion (Bartlett, S. Nelson) to approve May 22, 2023, Village Board meeting minutes as presented, Motion Carried (MC).

Nelson opened a public hearing to hear public comment on an application submitted by Stericycle, Inc., for a Solid Waste Disposal, Storage or Treatment Permit for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, to operate a regulated medical waste treatment facility utilizing Electro-Thermal Deactivation (shredding and thermal inactivation by use of low frequency radio waves) technology at 14035 Leetsbir Road and 14114 Leetsbir Road (Parcel ID #'s 194-03-21-24-002-130, 194-03-21-24-002-120, and 194-03-21-24-002-008) in the M-3 (Heavy Industrial) Zoning District
 - **Discussion** Travis Knautz (Facilities Manager, Stericycle) stated that little has changed since the last permitting cycle. They have passed all DNR audits and Racine Wastewater testing. He noted that due to Kestrel Hawk Landfill closing, they will now use GFL in Muskego. No public comments were made. D. Nelson closed the public hearing at 6:03 pm
- b. Application submitted by Stericycle, Inc., 14035 Leetsbir Road and 14114 Leetsbir Road, for a Solid Waste Disposal, Storage or Treatment Permit for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024 Motion (Bartlett, Funk) to approve the renewal of a Solid Waste Disposal, Storage or Treatment Permit for Stericycle for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 20, 2024, MC.
- c. **Public Hearing** At 6:04 p.m. D. Nelson opened a public hearing to hear public comment on an application on an application submitted by Daniels Sharpsmart, Inc., for a Solid Waste Disposal, Storage or Treatment Permit for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, to operate a regulated medical waste treatment facility utilizing Autoclave (steam sterilization treatment) technology at 1340 Grandview Parkway (Parcel ID # 194-03-21-13-029-070) in the M-3 (Heavy Industrial) Zoning District **Discussion** Zach Smith (State Operations Manager) noted no changes since the last permitting period except that they are running enclosed trailers instead of open-top dumpsters to the landfill now. No public comments were made. D. Nelson closed the public hearing at 6:05 p.m.

Extension request for a conditional use permit originally approved on December 13, 2021, and extended on August 8, 2022, to construct a nine-building self-service storage facility on the two vacant parcels located immediately to the west of 19411 Washington Avenue (STH 20), Sec. 07, T3N, R21E, Village of Yorkville, Racine County, Wisconsin (Parcel ID #'s 194-03-21-07-001- 022 and 194-03-21-07-001-023); Storage Authority, LLC, Owner; Storage Authority, LLC/Brian Depies/Short Elliott Hendrickson, Applicant/Agent
 - McKinney stated that Storage Authority is requesting a 9-month extension. Discussed limit on extension requests (no limit) and reason for Storage Authority's request (haven't been able to start yet).
 - Motion (S. Nelson, Funk) to approve the extension of the Conditional Use Permit for Storage Authority through May 31, 2024, MC.
- f. Site plan review application submitted by GIGI Associates LLC (with Endpoint Solutions/Jason Heinonen as applicant/agent) for the parcel located at 722 South Sylvania Avenue (West Frontage Road) (Parcel ID # 194-03-21-13-010-010) in the B-3 (Commercial Service) Zoning District for the addition of a second drive-thru lane and relocation of the patio area and dumpster enclosure associated with Culvers
 - Alysa Hogard (Culver's, Owner) outlined the plan to downsize and move the patio to the east side of the building, add a second drive-thru lane, and revamp the dumpster coral. The new lane will be closer to the building while the existing drive-thru lane will remain in the same space.

- h. Pond permit application submitted by Daniel Oakes for the property located at 2470 Queens Brook Lane (Parcel ID # 194-03-21-02-001-200) in the C-2 (Upland Resource Conservation) Zoning District to permit excavation of a 28,350-square foot pond
 - Daniel Oakes shared he is building a ½ acre pond because it's easier than digging a pool. McKinney stated Madsen reviewed the plan and is ok with it, noting it will be a landscaping pond, not a stormwater pond. Oakes confirmed the Certified Survey Map is complete with drain tile details.
 - Motion (Funk, Maurice) to approve Daniel Oakes' Pond permit for 2470 Queens Brook Lane as presented, MC.
- Public Hearing At 6:12 pm D. Nelson continued a joint public hearing to hear public comment on proposed revisions to Chapter 38 of the Village of Yorkville's Municipal Code of Ordinances relating to the adoption of an official map
 - McKinney stated Madsen added water and sewer infrastructure details, followed up with the State Aeronautics to check flight restrictions in the area (none), and updated the legal descriptions. No public comments. D. Nelson closed the hearing at 6:13 pm.

- k. **Public Hearing** At 6:14 pm D. Nelson continued a joint public hearing to hear public comment on proposed revisions to Chapters 14 and 55 of the Village of Yorkville's Municipal Code of Ordinances related to adult-oriented establishments.
 - Shepro reviewed the proposed revisions highlighting recent changes to both chapters, emphasizing that we are not regulating the businesses, but rather the secondary effects. Discussed the exclusion of I-94 as a protected corridor to ensure at least one area of Yorkville is viable for use by an adult-oriented establishment to comply with 1st amendment rights. Robin Christensen expressed concern that the licensing/background check process necessitated additional staff (not needed). She was assured additional staff would not be needed; similar processes are already in place for liquor licensing. D. Nelson closed the public hearing at 6:41 pm.

Though the Yorkville general budget item for Park and Recreation had been approved with an increase, there has not been a formal motion to approve the increased contribution Union Grove had requested.

Motion (Funk) to give \$12,000 to Union Grove and set aside the remainder for Yorkville needs, motion later withdrawn.

Motion (Funk, Maurice) to follow up with Union Grove regarding the unanswered questions and to consider action at a future meeting based on those findings, MC.
