2023 VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE DOG LICENSE FORM

Village residents are required to annually license each dog aged 5 months or older that they own; only three dogs can be kept upon each residential property. A kennel license is required to keep more than three dogs. 2023 dog licenses are available in mid-December and are valid until December 31, 2023. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required in order to license a new dog or if the rabies vaccination for a currently licensed dog has expired since the dog was last licensed. Proof of spay or neuter must also be provided for registration of a new dog to qualify for the spayed or neutered dog license fee. Registrations not submitted by March 31, 2023, are subject to a \$5.00 late fee. Any owner found to be in possession of an unlicensed dog is subject to a citation of \$124.00 for a first offense and \$187.00 for a second offense. Please send a completed dog license form, a copy of a current rabies vaccination certificate, proof of spay or neuter and a check for the license fee to: Village of Yorkville, 925 15th Avenue, Union Grove, Wisconsin 53182. The dog license fee can also be paid in person at the Village Office or via the drop box outside the main entrance to the Union Grove Municipal Center. This payment should not be combined with your property tax payment. If you no longer own a dog, please contact us so we can update our records accordingly.
