By signing this application, the undersigned agrees to adhere to the following:

- That dust and noise control measures will be maintained by the property owner.
- That off-road vehicles will be equipped with federally-approved spark arrestors, will not have been altered in any matter that effectively increases the noise associated with their operation (such as muffler modifications), and will not emit noise in excess of 96 decibels at a distance of 20 inches at one-half the vehicle's red-line speed, as measured in accordance with the procedure adopted by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources
- That no more than three riders, including no more than two riders who do not reside at the property, will operate off-road vehicles on the property at any given time.
- That any unvegetated riding area will be watered down before, during, and after riding, as needed, to control dust.
- That all private, off-road motor vehicle tracks will be readily accessible by emergency vehicles.
- That off-road vehicles will be operated only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and 12:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Sundays.

Permits granted under Sec. 50 Article III shall be reviewed annually by the village board and their renewal shall be conditioned upon the permittee's continued compliance with such conditions as the board may, from time to time, determine are necessary to safeguard the safety and welfare of the village's residents. The village board may waive or grant a partial variance from any requirement or prohibition created by this division if the board specifically determines that the permittee's special circumstances make such a waiver or variance appropriate.
