THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE, RACINE COUNTY, STATE OF WISCONSIN, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 137.25(1) provides that "[u]nless otherwise prohibited by law, with the consent of a governmental unit of this state that is to receive a record, any record that is required by law to be submitted in writing to that governmental unit and that requires a written signature may be submitted as an electronic record, and if submitted as an electronic record may incorporate an electronic signature"; and

WHEREAS, prior to this resolution, the Village of Yorkville has not formally consented to accepting electronic documents with electronic signatures; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to authorize submissions of electronic documents and electronic signatures in place of written records and written signatures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Yorkville hereby consents to receiving any records that are required by law to be submitted in writing with written signatures as electronic documents with electronic signatures.
