VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE RACINE COUNTY, STATE OF WISCONSIN

A RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE TOWN OF NORWAY FOR THE TRANSFER OF A RESERVE "CLASS B" ALCOHOL LICENSE ON BEHALF OF RANGE TIME LLC

WHEREAS, Ramiro Romo, agent of Range Time LLC, 14101, Washington Avenue, Sturtevant, Wisconsin, reached out to the Town of Norway, Racine County, Wisconsin, to inquire if the Town would be willing to transfer a reserve "Class B" alcohol license for issuance to him by the Village of Yorkville, since the Village currently has no such licenses left under its quota; and,

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Legislature 125.51(4)(e) allows municipalities to transfer an unused reserve "Class B" license to another municipality that it is within the same county; and,

WHEREAS, the transferring municipality establishes the initial issuance fee for the transferred reserve "Class B" license, in an amount not less than \$10,000. Upon receipt of the issuance fee, the receiving municipality must pay the issuance fee to the transferring municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the transfer of a reserve "Class B" license to another municipality is permanent. Once transferred, the receiving municipality's quota is increased, and the transferred municipality's quota is decreased; and,

WHEREAS, the Norway Town Clerk has confirmed that the Town has an available reserve "Class B" alcohol license.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Yorkville Village Board that:

- 1. The Village Board wishes request the transfer of an unused "Class B" alcohol license from the Town of Norway to the Village of Yorkville; and,
- 2. Upon transfer of such license by the Town to the Village, such license will be initially issued to Range Time, LLC, for such initial issuance fee as is set by Norway.
