VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE RACINE COUNTY, STATE OF WISCONSIN

AN ORDINANCE TO OPT OUT OF REGULATIONS REGARDING LENGTH AND WEIGHT LIMITS FOR IMPLEMENTS OF HUSBANDRY, AGRICULTURAL COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, AND 2-VEHICLE COMBINATIONS TRANSPORTING BY TRAILER OR SEMITRAILER AN IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY OR AGRICULTURAL COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE THAT EXCEEDS LIMITATIONS ON LENGTH OR WEIGHT, OR BOTH, THAT IS BEING TRANSPORTED TO OR FROM A FARM-RELATED DESTINATION, ON VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE HIGHWAYS AS AUTHORIZED BY WISCONSIN ACT 377

WHEREAS, 2013 Wisconsin Act 377, under Wis. Stats. § 348.27(19)(b)5.a., provides that a municipality or county may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Wis. Stats. § 340.01(24), agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Wis. Stats. § 340.01(10), and 2-vehicle combinations transporting by trailer or semitrailer an implement of husbandry or agricultural commercial motor vehicle that exceeds limitations on length or weight, or both, that is being transported to or from a farm-related destination, to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by Wis. Stats. Chapter 348.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Village Board of the Village of Yorkville, Racine County, State of Wisconsin, that, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 348.27(19)(b)5.a., implements of husbandry as defined in Wis. Stats. § 340.01(24), agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Wis. Stats. § 340.01(10), and 2-vehicle combinations transporting by trailer or semitrailer an implement of husbandry or agricultural commercial motor vehicle that exceeds limitations on length or weight, or both, that is being transported to or from a farm-related destination, may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Wis. Stats. Chapter 348, subject to seasonal and special posting restrictions or bridge and culvert weight limits, and

FURTHER, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the Village Board of the Village of Yorkville, Racine County, State of Wisconsin, and

FURTHER, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that the Clerk is hereby directed to provide a copy of this ordinance to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for posting on the Wisconsin Department of Transportation website, and

FURTHER, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that the Clerk is hereby directed to publish a summary of this ordinance upon its adoption, and

FURTHER, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that this ordinance take effect the day following its posting on the Wisconsin Department of Transportation website and its publication.
