BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, pursuant to Village of Yorkville Code of Ordinances 2-321(c), the minimum number of Election Inspectors required to work at each polling place during an election is three, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Administrator/Clerk is directed to schedule working hours for Election Inspectors and Chief Election Inspectors accordingly, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Administrator/Clerk is hereby directed to post this resolution in three places within thirty days of its adoption, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution and the appointments contained herein take effect the day following the posting of this resolution.
