

**Notification Form
Village of Yorkville
Sex Offender Residency**

- Pursuant to Sec. 30-130(d)(4) of the Village of Yorkville Code of Ordinances, a person falling within the definition of a Designated Offender under Sec. 30-130(c)(3) of the Village of Yorkville Code of Ordinance shall comply with the following:
 - (4) Notification. A Designated Offender must notify the Village Clerk a minimum of twenty-eight (28) days prior to establishing either a Permanent Residence or Temporary Residence within the Village of Yorkville.
- The purpose of this notification is to ensure that the Residency Restrictions and Safety Zones of the ordinance are complied with prior to a Designated Offender establishing a residence.
- Notification shall be accomplished by completing this form and filing it with the Village Clerk for the Village of Yorkville, 925 15th Avenue, Union Grove, WI 53182.
- When establishing or changing residency to a new location in the Village, a new notification form shall be completed and filed with the Village Clerk in accordance with this ordinance to verify compliance.

FAILURE TO NOTIFY THE VILLAGE MAY RESULT IN ISSUANCE OF A CITATION FOR VIOLATING THE VILLAGE'S ORDINANCE.
