



Village Board Meeting Minutes
Union Grove Municipal Center 925 15th Avenue
Tuesday, June 9, 2026

1. **Call to Order – Doug Nelson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.**

3. **Business - Discussion and possible action on the following:**

a. 67th Drive paving project presentation

Mark Eberle presented a comprehensive overview of the 67th Drive paving project. Key components discussed included trestle removal, trail regrading, signage updates, ditch de-brushing, culvert replacement, utility relocations, sidewalk installation, and the acquisition of additional land and right-of-way easements. Eberle noted that the project will require complex construction sequencing.

Connor LaPointe noted that the sidewalk portion of the project may be downsized or removed entirely, depending on the availability of grant funding. Eberle announced that a public information session is scheduled for June 10th. He provided a preliminary timeline, anticipating that plans and specifications will be completed and sent out for bid around July 14th, with contracted services finalized by September 1st. Construction is expected to begin after Labor Day and conclude before Christmas.

The Union Grove [Board/Committee/Council] adjourned their meeting at this time..

b. Resolution 2026-27 Setting forth and adopting the amended relocation order of the Village of Yorkville affecting property located within the Village having a Parcel ID number of 194-03-21-28-015-030, related to the planned reconstruction of 67th Drive

McKinney noted that the property, formerly owned by Harris, had been sold to Wilks. He provided an updated exhibit highlighting a slight change in the shape of the portion of land being acquired, but no change in the total acreage being acquired (roughly 0.15 acres).
