**RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE TO
APPROVE OF AND AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE
REMNANT DEFENDANTS' SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND FUTURE
SETTLEMENTS BORNE OUT OF OR OTHERWISE RELATED TO THE NATIONAL
OPIOID LITIGATION**

**THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF YORKVILLE, COUNTY OF
RACINE, STATE OF WISCONSIN, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

WHEREAS, the Village of Yorkville decided on or about November of 2019 to remain in the negotiation class of *In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation*, Case No. 17-md-2804, multidistrict litigation against opioid manufacturers, distributors, and retailers before Judge Dan A. Polster in the District Court for the Northern District of Ohio ("National Opioid Litigation"); and

WHEREAS, between 2021 and present, the Village of Yorkville has acted on the submission of several documents related other settlements and cases borne out of or otherwise related to the National Opioid Litigation; and

WHEREAS, the Village has been identified as a Participating Subdivision in the Remnant Defendants' Settlement Agreement ("RDSA") dated February 3, 2026, which involves the following six (6) Remnant Defendants that are parties to the RDSA: (1) Associated Pharmacies, Inc. (and American Associated Pharmacies), (2) J M Smith Corporation, (3) Morris and Dickson Co., L.L.C., (4) Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., (5) North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug , Inc., and (6) United Natural Foods, Inc. (and SuperValu); and

WHEREAS, participating class members, like the Village of Yorkville, must act on and submit a Participation Agreement for the RDSA by July 16, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Village will likely continue to be recognized as a Participating Subdivision in future settlements borne out of or otherwise related to the National Opioid Litigation; and

WHEREAS, it is the Village's intent to participate in those future settlements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Village of Yorkville wishes to participate in the RDSA and any future settlements borne out of or otherwise related to the National Opioid Settlements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Village Administrator is authorized to execute such required documents to effectuate the Village of Yorkville's desire to participate in such settlements and other Village staff members are authorized to take any other actions required to effectuate the Board's desire and that are consistent with

this action by the Village Board unless the Village Administrator, in his discretion, desires any such required documents be placed on an agenda for Village Board consideration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the law firm of von Briesen & Roper, s.c. will review the Village of Yorkville's participation documentation for such settlements at no cost to the Village of Yorkville.
